OASISS - Operation Against Smugglers Initiative on Safety and Security

The U.S. Border Patrol is using Adobe AIR, ColdFusion, Flex, and Studio 8 to create a desktop application that enables remote field agents to enter case information onto their laptop computers. When Internet access is available, the data is automatically saved to the agency's secure, centralized systems.

The City of Austin's AIMS Project team created an online training application to teach more than 1,000 city employees how to use a new financial management application. The training also has to be accessible to more than 25,000 citizens that do business with the city. Adobe solutions include Connect, Captivate, ColdFusion, Dreamweaver, Fireworks, Flash MX, and Photoshop 7.

Sleepy Hollow students created 100 digital videos that were part of an engaging streaming video web site. The videos were also incorporated into a digital yearbook. Adobe solutions used include After Effects 7, Audition, Bridge, Contribute, Creative Suite 2, Dreamweaver, Encore, Flash 8 Professional, Premiere Pro, and Studio 8.
